## Signing Ceremony Partnership Cooperation Agreement Between CMAC And JMAS For The Safety Village Construction Project

On 28 March 2016, The Cambodian Mine Action Centre (CMAC) and Japan Mine Action Service (JMAS) have agreed to engage in a Safety Village Construction Project (SVC Project), with the assistance of Komatsu Ltd. This is a post mine clearance, community development project.



This SVC project in Battambang Province involves the construction of four elementary schools, box culverts, new laterite roads as well as maintenance and widening of existing roads. Villages benefiting from the project include villages of Rong, Kong Pong Kul, and Borsknoe in Chaeng Meanchey Commune, and Boeung Prey in Snoeng Commune, Banan district. The project implementation will start on 01 April 2016 and finish on 31 March 2017. JMAS has agreed to support the project with funding of US\$275,000. The partnership cooperation agreement was signed on at CMAC headquarter in Phnom Penh on 28 March by **H.E. Mr Heng Ratana**, Delegate of the Royal Government in charge as Director General of CMAC and **Mr. Sako Nagatoshi**, Resident Representative of JMAS Cambodia.
