Of Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between CMAC and APOPO

H.E Heng Ratana, Advisor to Samdech Techo Prime Minister and Director General of the Cambodian Mine Action Centre (CMAC) and Mr. Andrew Sully, Program Manager, Anti-Persoonsmijnen Ontmijnende Product Ontwikkeling (APOPO) in Thailand, dually signed *Memorandum of Understanding (MOU)* at CMAC Headquarters, Phnom Penh on 28 September 2012.

CMAC and APOPO have agreed to work on the project for supporting the implementation of two CMAC Baseline Survey Teams to conduct baseline survey in 6 districts in the Eastern part of Cambodia during the period four month starting from 01st September 2012 to 31 December 2012.

Despite a small amount of **USD 44,177.37** to support two Baseline Survey Teams and one supervisor, this project will be evaluated by the end of 2012 and depending on the achievements in 2012, APOPO and CMAC will discuss a potential continuation of the project in 2013 and beyond.

This signing ceremony reflects the longer future cooperation between APOPO and CMAC in mine action sector in Cambodia.
